About Sustainability-related Supplier Analysis	
<i>Focus</i>	“From whom are we buying?”
<i>Purpose</i>	Identify whether the overall make-up of the organization’s supply base reflects its values, and whether individual suppliers present significant environmental, social, and economic performance risks.
<i>Analytical Questions</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do we have the right mix of small, medium, and diverse suppliers?</li> <li>• Are our biggest dollar suppliers sustainability leaders or laggards in their categories?</li> <li>• Do any of our suppliers present an out-sized sustainability risk for us?</li> </ul>
<i>Benefit</i>	Enables Strategy Planning to focus on aspects of the organization’s supplier selection processes that present the greatest opportunity to improve the supply base’s overall performance.
<i>General Method</i>	Pair purchase history data with information about supplier characteristics and supplier performance history from an environmental, social, and economic perspective.
<i>When to Use</i>	When the aspect of environmental, social, and economic performance being evaluated is associated with characteristics of a supplier or the supply base, as a whole.
<i>Data Source Examples</i>	Data reported publicly or directly by suppliers; audit or third-party verified data; standards and certifications; regulatory compliance data
